

INSTALLER APPRENTICE

DESCRIPTION

Installer apprentice is a position of learning and gaining experience through YF crew members and leaders. The main priority is to be a helpful part of the team and learn proper installation, machine and equipment operation, and safety standards. Moving past apprenticeship to installer will require an individual's willingness to learn, grow, and develop as a skilled tradesman.

DUTIES

- Learning installation techniques
- Learning machine and equipment operation
- Keeping equipment, machines, tools, and vehicles clean and maintained
- Learning and executing safety requirements
- Becoming an active team member
- Proper communication with crew members and leaders
- Eagerness to learn and grow
- Positive attitude
- Being punctual and reliable
- Going beyond duties and tasks
- Follow company standards

REQUIREMENTS

The goal for an apprentice is to learn, grow and become a more prominent role in the YF Company. Applicants must show willingness and progress during apprenticeship to remain part of the company. Failure to progress will result in termination. Apprentice must maintain a safe and clean record. Must be able to communicate with members of team. They must strive to be a useful team member and not just an individual. They must go beyond expectations of tasks given by other members.

WORK WEEK

An average workweek is 45 hours per week (five 9 hour days). The standard week is 7:30 am to 4:30 pm. If unable to work due to weather or other circumstances, then days will be made up on Saturdays.
